

Culture, Community & Commitment: Honoring South Florida's Jamaican Alumni Associations

This February we are celebrating Black History Month, and it is only fitting that we look at Jamaican Alumni Associations here in South Florida and recognize their profound contributions to the region. Jamaican Alumni Associations are among the most influential groups shaping cultural and civic life in South Florida, and education in Jamaica. Their work stands as a testament to the power of diaspora communities to uplift not only their members but the broader society they call home, and students in Jamaica.

A Legacy Rooted in Education and Service

Most of these associations in South Florida began as small gatherings of graduates who wanted to stay connected to their alma maters back home. Over time, these groups evolved into powerful engines of philanthropy, mentorship, and cultural preservation. Today, dozens of associations representing primary, high schools and colleges across Jamaica operate throughout South Florida.

Their mission is consistent and deeply impactful:

- Support education in Jamaica through scholarships, health missions, school supplies, infrastructure projects, sports, and teacher development.
- Strengthen the Jamaican diaspora by offering networking opportunities, professional development, and community support.
- Promote cultural pride through events (galas, dance, picnics, barbeques and fish fries, and family days) that celebrate Jamaican heritage, music, food, sports, and traditions.

These organizations have become pillars of the Jamaican-American community, bridging generations and fostering a sense of belonging for Jamaicans who now call South Florida home.

Unity Amplified: The Coalition of Jamaican Alumni Associations

Recognizing the power of collaboration, the Coalition of Jamaican Alumni Associations of Florida (CJAAF) was formed in 2006 and incorporated in 2010. The CJAAF is the umbrella association that amplifies the reach and impact of individual associations. The CJAAF has become a model of diaspora cooperation, demonstrating how collective action and support can transform communities both locally and abroad.

The Coalition's contributions include:

- Coordinated activities that support students in Jamaica and Jamaican-American youth in South Florida.
- Coordinated and at times joint fundraising initiatives that allow schools in Jamaica to receive larger, more sustainable support.
- Support through the publication of a monthly newsletter, and free advertising on the CJAAF's Website of alumni events.
- An annual walkathon that bring together Jamaicans and friends of Jamaica, strengthening ties across the diaspora. This event also provides opportunities for individual associations to raise funds.

Through the CJAAF, alumni associations have been able to pool resources, share expertise, and create a unified voice advocating for education, cultural preservation, and community empowerment.

Strengthening South Florida Through Jamaican Leadership

The influence of Jamaican alumni groups extends far beyond their own membership. Their events, partnerships, and philanthropic efforts enrich South Florida's multicultural landscape. They collaborate with local civic organizations and government agencies, and contribute to:

- Economic empowerment initiatives that support small businesses and professional networking.

- Cultural festivals and heritage celebrations that enhance South Florida’s reputation as a vibrant hub for Caribbean nationals.

These contributions help foster a more inclusive, dynamic, and culturally aware South Florida—one where Caribbean voices are recognized as essential to the region’s identity.

A Continuing Story of Excellence

As we honor Black History Month, the work of Jamaican Alumni Associations and the CJAAF

reminds us that history is not only about the past—it is also about the ongoing efforts of communities who build, uplift, and inspire. Their dedication to education, service, and cultural pride continues to shape South Florida in meaningful ways.

The story of Jamaican alumni in South Florida is a story of resilience, unity, and unwavering commitment to progress. It is a story worth celebrating—not just in February, but all year long.




