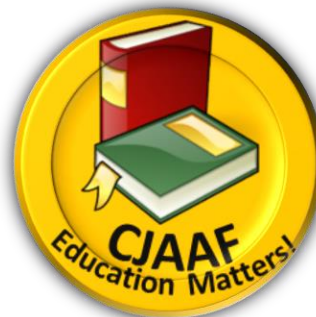

#### More than a Decade of Dedicated Partnership



For more than ten years, this remarkable group of women has been a cornerstone of support for the Coalition's Annual Walkathon. Their commitment goes far beyond financial contributions. While they consistently cover participation fees, they also contribute to the event by donating essential supplies of food and water to manning the service lines with tireless energy. This certainly embodies the spirit of community. This dedication was on full display at the 2025 Walkathon. MBHS Alumnae South Florida went above and beyond by donating every ingredient for the event's signature codfish fritters, which they personally prepared and served.

#### Empowering the Next Generation

The MBHS Alumnae Florida has maintained a deep and enduring connection to their alma mater. For over thirty-five years, they have provided vital financial assistance to their alma mater, ensuring that current students have the resources they need to thrive. Proving their steadfast support, the group donated US\$6,000 in 2024, followed by another US\$6,000 in 2025.

#### Compassion in the Local Community

Closer to home, MBHS Florida Alumnae have established themselves as a constant partner to the Broward County Shelter for the Homeless. Over the years, they have organized toy drives and supported







local breakfast programs. In 2025, they supplemented their hands-on work with a \$300 donation. After recognizing a specific need during this past holiday season, they pivoted from their traditional toy drive to donate thirty pairs of children's pajamas, ensuring comfort and warmth for the shelter's youngest residents.

## REV. HORACE D. WARD, THE PEOPLE'S PASTOR RETIRES

On December 8, 2025, The Reverend Horace D. Ward, often referred to as "the people's pastor," retired from the ministry after nearly 50 years of service. Affectionately called Fr. Ward, his path to the ministry began in Jamaica, where he was ordained as a priest in the Anglican Diocese of Jamaica and the Cayman Islands. Fr. Ward served as Rector of the Episcopal Church of the Holy Family in Miami Gardens for nearly 30 years. Under his leadership, the church has become a pillar of the community, hosting food distributions, job fairs, and youth development programs.



A graduate of Wolmer's Boys School and the University of the West Indies Father Ward also pursued post-graduate studies at St. Thomas University and Drew University. Aligned with the Wolmer's High School Motto, "Age Quod Agis" - *Do well whatever you do*, Father Ward gave his all to whatever task was before him, whether big or small. Fr. Ward's retirement from active ministry marks the culmination of a career built on genuine service. His leadership roles have included:

- Chair of the Miami Gardens Ecumenical Clergy Group.
- Citizen Advisory Committee member for the Miami Gardens Police Department.
- Jamaica Diaspora Board Representative (Interim 2013–2014).



While Fr. Ward's formal retirement marks the end of his daily duties as Rector, his legacy is defined by his commitment to "the next generation" and his belief that the church must adapt to modern times using technology and community engagement. Even as he transitions out of his official role, his influence will remain throughout South Florida, especially in the Jamaican Alumni Community.

### **DINTHILL TECHNICAL HIGH SCHOOL ALUMNI ASSOCIATION OF FLORIDA REFURBISH GREENHOUSE TO BOOST AGRICULTURAL PROGRAM AT SCHOOL**

#### **Linstead, January 13, 2026, Refurbishment of Greenhouse**

Dinthill Technical High School Alumni Association of Florida (DTHSAAF) has completed the refurbishment of Greenhouse #1 at the school. This Greenhouse suffered damages from Tropical Storm Ian in 2022, Hurricane Beryl in 2024 and finally completely ripped apart by Hurricane Melissa in 2025.

As the premier Agricultural School in Jamaica, this situation created a near crisis for the school as the Greenhouse is used for tutorial and practical experiences for teaching and learning, as well as for commercial crops.

The principal Mr. Anthony Garwood was elated and said, "putting the Greenhouse back in service will enhance the practical experience for teachers and students, and will help the school generate income from greenhouse crops."

DTHSAAF just could not allow the school to be without a functioning Greenhouse and set out to have this situation remedied as soon as possible. Project leader from the association, VP Clayton Todd stated "We exist to enhance the student experience at the school and voted to "fast track" this project following hurricane Melissa's passage ". The cost of the project was approximately six thousand United States dollars, and we would like to extend special thanks to 1968 graduate Winston Cole and 1980 graduate Dr. Easton Douglas (Easton R. Douglas, D.D.S) for their support.

We plan to address Greenhouse # 2 following our Spring Ball being held on Saturday, March 14, 2026, in Coral Springs Florida.

#### **About Dinthill Technical High School Alumni Association of Florida**

DTHSAAF, formed in 1988, was recognized as a 501C3 Nonprofit organization by the Internal Revenue Service in 2005. Since its inception the organization has contributed immensely to the school's development as well as student welfare. Some areas of support include furnishing a Computer Laboratory (Maria Pazos Computer Laboratory), Donation of 150 chairs, awarding of Scholarships and Bursaries, refurbishment of the basketball court, donations to Home Economics and Sports Departments, contribute to the Dinthill Trust Fund to name a few.

Dinthill Technical High School was founded in 1938 as a vocational training center in Jamaica, focusing on agriculture and trades for young men, evolving into a comprehensive technical high school for both genders, emphasizing STEM, agriculture, and producing well-rounded graduates, known for its motto "Facta Non Verba" (Deeds Not Words) and strong presence in academics and sports.

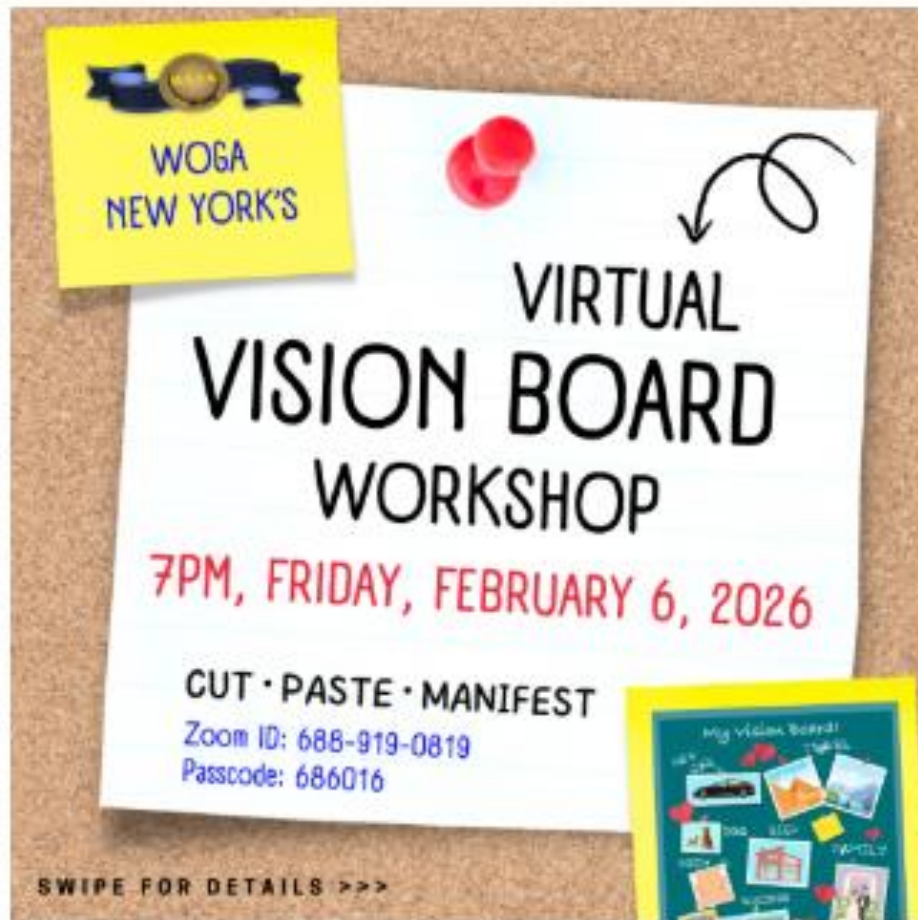

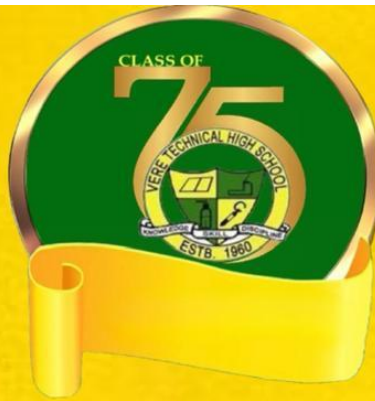

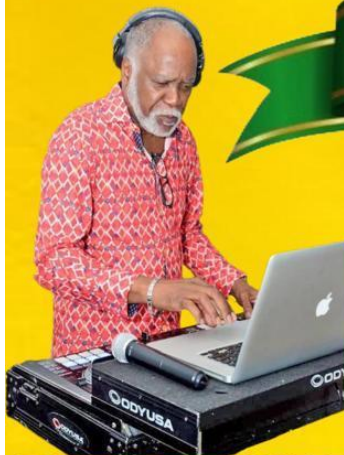
