- Two (2) current letters of recommendation (one character and the other, academic)
- A certified UWI transcript that indicates the student is in good standing.

- A certified copy of birth certificate.
- Picture (Head shot) of applicant.

Method of Selection:

Review by Committee of UWIAA Florida Chapter Members

Payment to awardee:

- Funds will be disbursed to the successful applicant through the university controller/financial aid office.
- After notification of scholarship, the successful applicant must submit their school identification number to the Florida Chapter of the University of the West Indies Alumni Association.

NOTE:

- The award may not be held jointly with any other UWI Florida Alumni Scholarship.
- The award may not be held jointly with any other scholarship or bursary where together the value exceeds the cost of tuition.
