

## THE DR. BEVERLY FRAY MODERN LANGUAGES & POLITICAL SCIENCE SCHOLARSHIP

The Dr. Beverly Fray Modern Languages & Political Science Scholarship is open to incoming undergraduate students from Westwood High School who have been accepted to the University of the West Indies, intending to pursue a degree in modern languages, political science, or a related interdisciplinary field.

- Applicants must have achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5 (or equivalent) in their secondary education, demonstrating strong academic performance across humanities and social science subjects.
- Candidates should possess demonstrable proficiency in at least one language in addition to their native tongue, evidenced by formal certification, coursework, or equivalent experience.
- Applicants are required to submit a personal statement of no more than 500 words articulating their passion for language study and political engagement, two letters of recommendation from teachers or mentors in relevant subject areas, and a copy of their university acceptance letter.
- Preference will be given to students who have shown active involvement in community, civic, or international affairs — such as model UN participation, debate, volunteering, or cultural exchange programs.
- The scholarship is intended for full-time or part-time students and recipients must maintain a minimum GPA of 3.3 throughout their studies to retain eligibility for annual renewal.

**Number of Awards:** One (1)

**Value:** US\$500.00

**Tenure:** One (1) Year

### Eligibility

The award is available to students registered in the Faculty of Humanities & Education, or Social Sciences, and pursuing modern languages, political science, or a related interdisciplinary field.

### Criteria

The award will be based on:

- Verifiable financial need and academic achievement (*GPA of 3.5 or higher required*)

**What should be included in the application?**

- A brief statement no more than 500 words articulating the applicant's passion for their field of study.
- Two (2) current letters of recommendation (one character and the other, academic)
- Official UWI transcript that indicates that student is in good standing.

- Committee of UWIAA Florida Chapter members

**Payment to Awardee:**

- Funds will be disbursed to the successful applicant through the University controller/financial aid office
- After notification of award, the successful applicant will submit their school ID number to the Florida Chapter of the University of the West Indies Alumni Association.
