

On August 9, the Jamaica Observer Published the following article "KNOCKALVA POLYTECHNIC COLLEGE CELEBRATES 85 YEARS". Many individuals from Jamaica do not know where Knockalva Polytechnic College is located and how important it is to the economic development of Jamaica. Here is some information about Knockalva Polytechnic College.

Knockalva Polytechnic College is located in Ramble, Hanover Parish, in western Jamaica. The institution began in 1940 as the Knockalva Agricultural School and was officially upgraded to a polytechnic college in 2018, expanding its course offerings while retaining a strong agricultural focus. Over the years, it has grown to offer associate degrees and certifications across

multiple disciplines: agriculture, environmental science, health & wellness tourism, computer engineering technology, agri-processing, and business management.

Knockalva Polytechnic College is playing a pivotal role in Jamaica's economic development, notably through agriculture, vocational training, and rural empowerment.

- The Ministry of Agriculture has identified Knockalva as a key partner in efforts to resurge Jamaica's dairy industry. Plans include developing fodder, constructing a milking parlour, providing cattle, and utilizing college lands for production. (Jamaica Observer, April 2, 2024).
- Knockalva is also playing a role in the Dairy Livestock Innovation and Nutrition Programme (DLINK), with students being trained to maintain essential dairy equipment—such as milking machines and cooling tanks—ensuring sustainable industry support. (Jamaica Observer, December 6, 2024)
- Knockalva is offering more opportunities for individuals to gain tertiary education training. The 2018 transformation into a polytechnic marked a strategic shift toward offering industry-responsive programmes, including technical and vocational training, entrepreneurship, and applied research—similar to what the University of the West Indies (Mona) does for eastern Jamaica. Knockalva can become a hub for technical innovation, sustainable farming, and environmental management.

As Principal Natalie Thompson noted in a press briefing held at the Rural Agricultural Development Authority's (RADA) St James office recently, "Knockalva's Legacy of Excellence: 85 Years of Shaping Futures, speaks to the rich history, transformative work, and continued commitment to prepare the next generation of leaders, innovators, and change makers."

We salute Knockalva Polytechnic College for its contribution to education in Jamaica over its 85 years of existence, and laud **Dr. Gersham Nelson** and members of the Knockalva Alumni Association for their commitment to their alma mater.






